What to Bring for Campers

What To Bring

Bible (physical bible, not a phone app), sleeping bag or bedding for twin bed, toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.), towels, sunscreen, clothes to get wet in (**If a camper wears a swimsuit or inappropriate t-shirt/short shorts, they will be asked to change and wear clothes provided by chaperones**), socks, tennis shoes, foldable lawn chair.

Optional Items: sports equipment, roof fan, alarm clock, camera, personal money for Starbucks or Chapstore. Please identify your belongings with your name.

Please do not bring expensive electronic equipment. We do our best to secure dorm rooms throughout the week, but LCU will not be held responsible for lost or stolen items.

Arrival and Departure

Check-in for camp will be in Johnson Hall

Monday 5-7pm. Please make plans to arrive within the stated time frame for registration. *Light dinner will be provided at this time. Late arrivals will not be guaranteed food.*

Check-out is 10am after the end of worship on Thursday.

You must check out and return your keys. You will be responsible for any repair costs to damaged rooms and any lost keys.

Medications

Campers will be responsible for any prescribed medications. Ensure your chaperone is aware of any special instructions or conditions.

Payment of Account

Please try to pay camper balances prior to arriving to camp. Any unpaid fees will be taken on registration day. If payment is received prior to camp, deposits are non-refundable and can not be transferred. If a camper does not attend camp, the fees will be forfeited.

Summer Camp Guidelines

1. For continuity and safety, all camps are closed campus. Campers are not allowed to leave campus and no parents or visitors are allowed in the dorms or on campus.
2. Any illness or accident should be reported to your counselor as soon as possible. A nurse is on duty throughout the week.
3. Tobacco, alcohol, drugs and weapons are not permitted on the LCU campus or anywhere camp goes as a group.
4. We reserve the right to confiscate anything we feel necessary and retain it at our discretion.
5. Roller blades and skateboards will not be allowed at camp, not even for transportation or use during Free Time. These items will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp.
6. Camp personnel reserve the right to remove anyone from campus for disorderly conduct, lack of cooperation or violation of guidelines. No refunds will be given.
7. Shorts may be worn at camp. **Shorts must be modest in style and length, mid-thigh or longer and appear modest while standing and sitting.** Any clothing, accessories or symbols that imply gang affiliation are not acceptable and will not be allowed. **No tank tops or midriff shirts will be allowed.**
8. Cell phones will be permitted, but will be required to **remain in the dorm rooms at all times.**
